"Renoir: The Body, The Senses"

special exhibition at the Kimbell Art Museum

The Kimbell's description--

"The body—particularly the nude—was the defining subject of Renoir's artistic practice from his early days as a student copying the old masters in the Louvre to the early twentieth century, when his revolutionary style of painting inspired the masters of modernism. This exhibition has been organized in recognition of **the centenary of Renoir's death.**

This daring exhibition is the first major exploration of Renoir's unceasing interest in the human form, and it reconsiders Renoir as a constantly evolving artist whose style moved from Realism into luminous Impressionism, culminating in the modern classicism of his last decades.



Renoir's respect for tradition will be demonstrated by comparison with paintings by Peter Paul Rubens, Eugène Delacroix, and Camille Corot. His distinct approach to the subject of bathers will be underscored in a comparison of some of his most notable works with this subject. His profound influence on future generations will be seen in additional comparisons with other masters in the depiction of the nude."
